**Until we discover the right questions we can't find the right answer.**

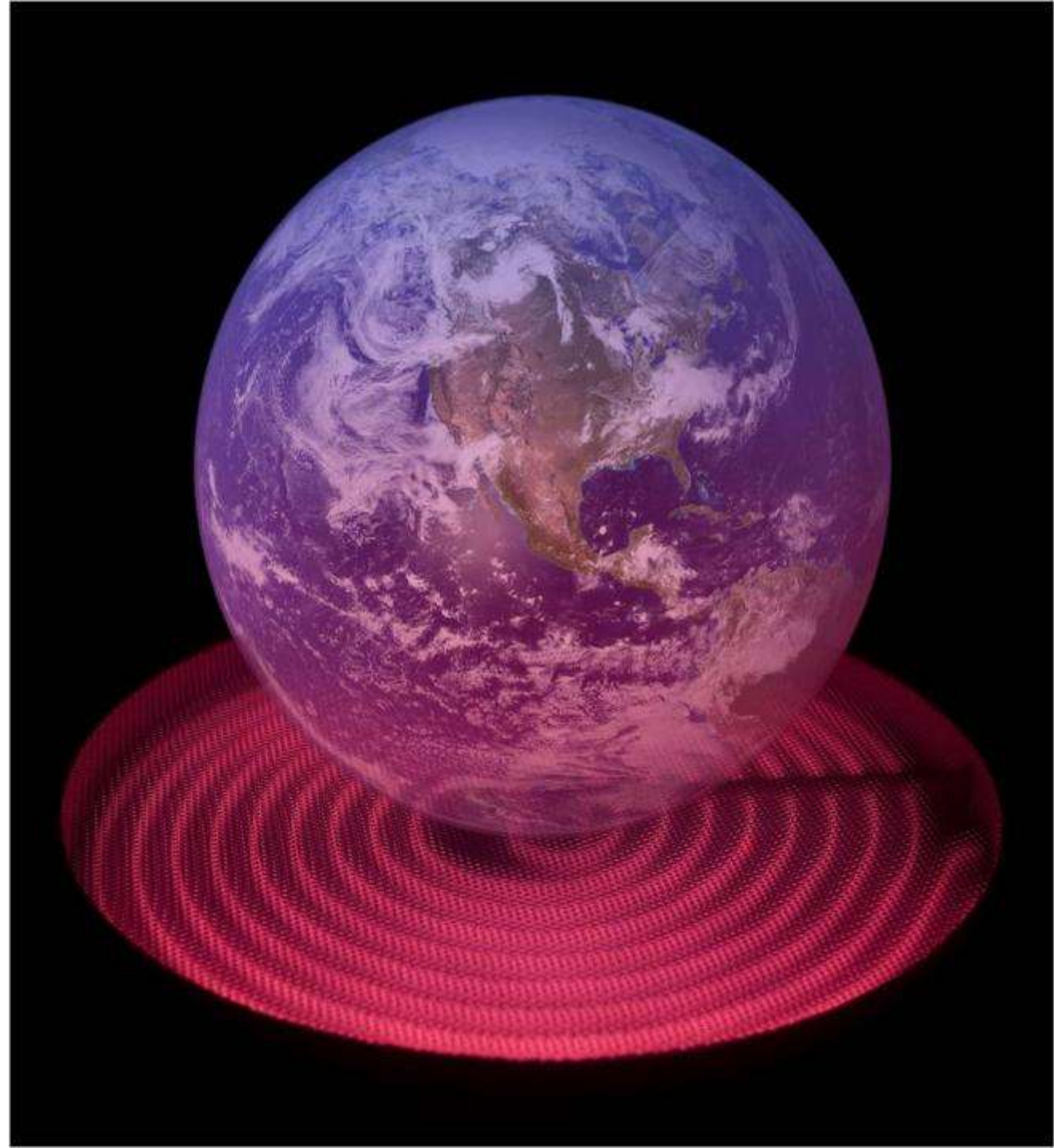


# Closed-Ended Questions

- Journalistic questions like who, what, when, and where are closed-ended questions leading to short answers that end not only the conversation, but the exploration of what really happened or is happening.

# Open-Ended Questions

- **Why?**
- **What if?**
  - These are open-ended questions that lead to all sorts of possible answers.
  - As you go along each week in each course ask yourself and one another "Why" and "What if" questions a lot!
